

Timeline

Some things go into effect immediately; **Medicaid cuts may not be felt until 2027.**

The law's "benefits" - like tipped income tax exemption and saving accounts for kids - **expire by 2029.**

But, the law's drafters made sure to set tax handouts for the ultra-wealthy as **permanent.**
