

Health Care For All

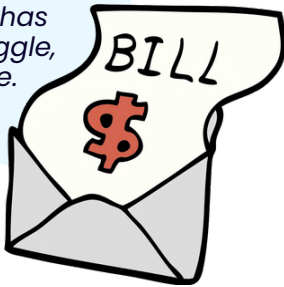
We shouldn't have to worry about medical bills.

If you don't have insurance right now or paying for it has become a struggle, you're not alone.



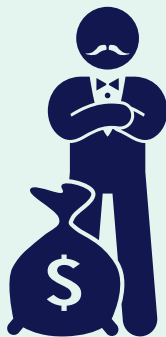
Yet, nearly half of working-age adults in the U.S. struggled to afford health care in 2025. (*Karpman, et al, 2026*)

Americans owe around **\$88 billion** in medical debt. (*CFPB, 2022*)

In the U.S., **we pay more** for health care compared to other wealthy nations. (*Peterson KFF, 2025*)

Why is health care in the U.S. so expensive?

Instead of easing costs for individuals and hospitals, some of our lawmakers **took away our health care funding** and used it to fund **tax cuts for the richest and mass deportations.**



And, for too long, some of our lawmakers have **allowed companies to put profits over our health and our lives.**



- **The 2025 budget bill** made massive cuts to health programs that help our communities, like Medicaid, Medicare, and the Affordable Care Act (ACA).
- The bill could lead to as many as **15 million people losing health insurance**, and is expected to drive the cost of care even higher. (*Rosenthal, 2026, Kaiser Family Foundation, 2025*)
- Already, **more than 1 in 5 people enrolled in ACA plans couldn't afford their first monthly premium** in January and lost their coverage. (*NOTUS, 2026*)
- Health insurance companies have **pocketed billions in profits** in the last few years. (*Abelson, 2020*)
- Meanwhile, the **cost of health insurance has risen 3 times faster** than what workers are paid. (*Kanimian, Ho, 2025*)
